

Seniors Section ETIQUETTE and MINOR RULES GUIDE THE 10 COMMANDMENTS

GENERAL PLAY

- 1. Play thy game as you expect others to play it, having respect for thy partner's position and needs on the course.
- 2. Check in early and get to the tee on time (at least 5 mins before tee-off) do not keep thy playing partner(s) waiting.
- 3. Help to search for thy partner's ball (if you don't this <u>will</u> be remembered later when you need their help)!
- 4. Take cognisance of the call up holes (2nd and 16th)!

TEEING OFF

- 5. Declare thy ball before teeing off and thy subsequent provisional ball (making sure it is distinguishable from first)!
- 6. 'tis basic courtesy to watch thy partner's drive and indicate where it went (especially in bright sunlight)!
- 7. Remember, Three² minutes search time is for thy ball not thy tee!

PUTTING OUT

- 8. Taketh thy turn to putt but giveth thy partner the option to putt out first.
- 9. Step ye not on thy partner's putting line ('tis tantamount to stepping on their grave)!
- 10.1f you have putted out (or picked up), 'tis also basic courtesy to witness thy partner's putt - head ye not to next tee in ignorance of the result!
